- Jabardaan Gadhvi of Kutch immolated himself after several attempts to get just a piece of information. He was entitled legally and their was no response despite representations from bottom to top.

- The government which runs after handful of industrialists neglects the common man to an extent that he if forced to immolate himself.

Jabardaan Gadhvi was forced for immolate self outside a mamlatdar office in Kutch district against injustice by the state government. It is the most shameful incident of Swarnim year when the state government and its administration are sleeping until a common man fighting for justice has to self immolate.

Condemning the incident Leader of opposition Shaktisinh Gohil said that industrialists were given valuable land at cheap rates in the name of Vibrant Gujarat but a common man has to give up his life when he does not get details of his land for which he is entitled legally.
